

About Bass 1 and 2:

The long notes in B1 and B2 in the first parts of the verses can be left out if necessary. This way it is "only" a 2-part bass and not a 4-part bass.

About the melody/solo:

The score can be sung without a soloist. In that case the first sopranos will be split into two sections in bar 1-5 carrying the D that is already notated in the S1 and the A notated in the S2.

The melody will then be carried by the S2 from bar 4-20 + bar 108-109 and by A1 from bar 77-82. In bar 83-84 the A1 will sing the lower voices notated in the S2 and the S2 will sing the upper voice notated in the S2.

In bar 83-84, the A2 will then sing an F instead of an E or briefly split into 2 sections and sing both the A2 and the A1 part, so we get the clash.
The soli in bar 97-107 can be left out completely if necessary or you can choose to sing it 1-part.
